- Pool Deck—The new Pool deck is complete for the most part. A few things that will be done after the cement cures is sealing & they will add a anti-fungus solution to the sealant.
- Pool Shell— We have a contract to begin work on the pool shell for the first week of April.
- Indoor Tennis— We met with the vendor, Signature, last week. It doesn't look like their schedule will be able to have the structure done by May 1, so we have decided to begin construction after Labor Day to avoid inconvenience to our membership using the tennis courts this spring.
