PROJECT UPDATE

- The new Pool deck is scheduled to be complete by November 19th. The company we are working with understands our drainage issues & are working hard to fix them. They are also putting in new hardware for a lot of our fixtures i.e. poles for the flags, diving blocks. We will be doing the pool shell in the spring, so it is nice & shiny for the season.
- The building permit is complete for the two clay tennis courts in the northwest corner. Our goal it to have construction complete by spring 2009.
- The club is working with the City of Boulder on the platform courts approvals & permits.
- A building manufacturer for the indoor tennis court structure will be selected soon. Once that is complete, a Minor Modification review and building permit package will be prepared for City of Boulder review.
